NEW PORTERSTOWN PARK ALL-WEATHER PITCH CAR PARKING GUIDANCE

First the good news. The construction of our new all-weather pitch in Porterstown Park has started and while it could take the rest of the year to complete, it will be worth the wait, as we will have a state of the art full size all weather playing pitch in 2023.



However, during construction, we will encounter difficulties as regards car parking and playing pitches at Porterstown Park.

For the rest of this year **SEVERE PARKING RESTRICTIONS** will apply in our car park. To minimise traffic congestion, **please adhere to the following**:

- 1. ONLY visiting teams and those with a disability to use car park.
- 2. Home team players, coaches & families should choose from the following options to avoid potential health & safety risks from traffic congestion:
 - A. Walk or cycle to park, if possible, using pedestrian lights to cross road.
 - B. Adopt car-pooling with other club members to reduce traffic.
 - C. Managers / families assemble players away from Porterstown Park and car share to drop players at car park. Do not park in car park please.
 - D. Managers to leave their equipment, balls etc in clubhouse in advance of match day so they don't need to take car to Porterstown on match day.
- 3. Church car park (located between park entrance & church building) not in use for Porterstown Park users <u>except</u>, <u>when available</u>, <u>for visiting teams only on Saturdays</u>.
- 4. Traffic Marshals instructions MUST be obeyed at all times.

The above guidelines are subject to ongoing review.

In relation to PLAYING PITCHES, there will also be disruption but with careful management, we hope to keep this to a minimum, and of course it will be worth it in the end when we will have the 3G full sized all weather pitch in Porterstown Park.
